Online submission of application for admission to B.L.I.Sc Course 2017-18

Eligibility Criteria For Bachelor of Library and Information Science Course

For Candidates under OBC-A & OBC-B category	An Honours and/or Master's Degree in any subject or equivalent degree with a minimum of 45% marks in any level from any recognized institution, with a minimum of 45% marks in the H.S or equivalent examination.

- All applicants must have completed results of Bachelor's and/or Masters Degree course or equivalent degree from any University/Institute recognized by the UGC and completed result in Certificate in Library & Information Science at the time of application.
- Applications with incomplete results shall be rejected. A candidate shall be denied admission (even if he/she is provisionally selected on the basis of information provided by the applicant) if, at the time of verification of results, it is detected by the Faculty Office/Department of Library and Information Science that his/her results are not complete.
- OBC-A & OBC-B candidates who have already applied but did not get admission under General category will also be considered in the fresh merit list under OBC-A & OBC-B category. They need not to fill the online application form again.
- For candidates under OBC Quota:

The candidates who will be provisionally selected under the OBC- A and OBC- B categories must produce an OBC certificate (the date of issue of the certificate should not be earlier than June 2016) issued by the competent authority that clearly indicates (i) the category (A or B) they belong to; (ii) that they do not belong to creamy layer of the society, at the time of counselling/ admission ([Click Here for details](#)).

OBC-A and OBC-B candidates of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal, unless they can produce a domicile certificate of 10-year residency issued by competent authority.

- Jadavpur University has accepted in principle that each and every student of the University shall be duty bound during the entire period of studentship with the University to immediately report to the Dean of Students if any ragging is noticed either in University hostel or on University campus.
- If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the Authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the Authority would expel him/her from the University.
